ATLANTIC OCEAN PASSAGE

As we begin our crossing of the vast Atlantic Ocean from Miami toward the Azores, we are sailing across the second-largest ocean on Earth, spanning over 41 million square miles. At its deepest point, the Atlantic reaches more than 8,000 meters, while much of the ocean floor remains largely unexplored. Beneath us runs the Mid-Atlantic Ridge, a vast underwater mountain range that stretches nearly the entire length of the ocean. The Atlantic is also shaped by powerful currents, including the Gulf Stream, which carries warm water northward and plays a vital role in regulating global climate. These waters have been travelled for centuries, linking continents through exploration, migration, and trade. Today, as we journey eastward, we follow historic transatlantic routes, experiencing firsthand the scale, power, and enduring significance of this remarkable ocean.

The Rower & Author lives in Fishbourne on the Isle of Wight. He is a retired stockbroker and happily married with three children.
